- Each year in the United States, more than **21,000** women are diagnosed with ovarian cancer and about **15,000** women die of the disease.
- Ovarian cancer is the **deadliest of all gynecologic cancers**.
- Pap smears **do not screen** for ovarian cancer and there are currently **no early detection tests** for the disease.
- The **symptoms** of ovarian cancer are:

Bloating that is persistent

Eating less and feeling fuller

Abdominal pain

Trouble with your bladder
